Richard Bowden, (no relation) **Val Powell** and **Paul Venn** have also passed just recently, but sadly the postman has yet to arrive for these

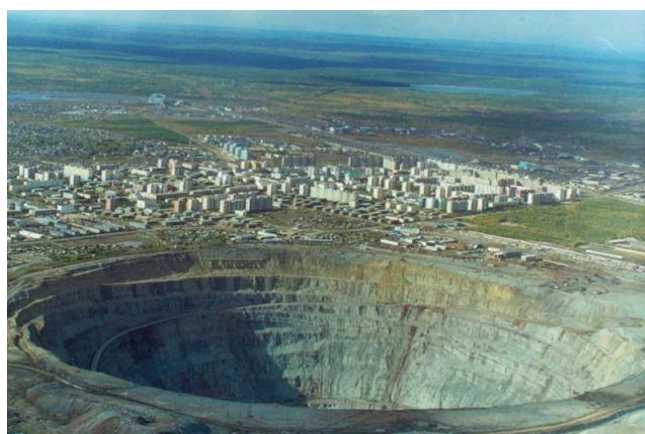
worthy individuals (still, at least you all get a second mention!).
